

### Location Data Download (NAESB WGQ Standard No. 0.4.4)

The Location Data Download is a report that is provided by a Transportation Service Provider (TSP) which contains location data for the TSP.

The report should be represented in CSV format and should be available for download from the TSPs Informational Postings Website.

### Steps to Implement

- 1. Update Interconnects in NGI
- 2. Create the file from NGI
- 3. Upload the file to your Informational Postings Website



# Step 1: Update Interconnects in NGI

As an Operator, go to <u>Interconnect Mgmt</u> and click on an interconnect to Edit. Required fields are highlighted below.

## Step 2: Create Location Data file in NGI

Once you have updated all of your Interconnects, you are ready to create the file.

Just go to Interconnect Mgmt, and click on "Download Location Data". Save the file to a location that you will remember (you will need it in Step 3).

## Step 3: Upload the file to Informational Postings Website

Once logged in, look for "Locations" under the Misc section of the left-side navigation.
